Will thanks be to god do make & publish this writing as for my last
Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say
first I give to my Son Jacob Barnes one Tree and Furniture some

of Land lying on the West side of the Cypress Road adjoining the
Lands of William Foster & Jacob Barris to hold to my sd son
Joshua and to his Heirs and Assigns forever also I give to my
said son Joshua one Bed and Furniture one Cow and calf also I
give to my son James Barris the Lands and Plantation where
on I now live as far as a line of Market Trees crossing the said
Land from the side line to the Cypress Swamp to hold to my
sd son James and to his Heirs and Assigns forever also I give
to my sd son James one Cow and calf also I give to my son
Burrnell Barris all that part of the Tract or Parcel of Land
that lies on the Cypress Swamp above the Crop Line having
already given the lower part to my son James to hold to my
sd son Burrnell and to his Heirs & Assigns forever also I give
to my sd son Burrnell one Gun and Bayonet some Cow and
calf also I give to my Daughter Mary Barrett one Cow

Cal also I give to my Daughter Priscilla Barris one Pewter
Basin also I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Barris one
Pewter Basin also I give to my Daughter Martha Barris
one Pewter Dish and the best and residue of my Personal
Estate undisposed of by this my Will I give to my loving
Wife Elizabeth during her Life a Widow but if she my
Wife should marry or at her Decease I give the sd Residue
part of my Estate to be Equally Divided between my
Wife and of my sd Sons James and Barwell and three of
my sd Daughters Priscilla Elizabeth and Martha and do
hereby constitute and appoint my Son Jacob Executor of this
my last Will hereby revoking all others by me heretofore
made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand
and this 15th Day of July 1761.
