Southampton County being weak of Body but of sound
Mind and memory do make this my last Will & Testament
in manner and forme as followeth.

I give and bequeath unto my son Hardy Doyle the Land
where he now lives beginning on Sarasota Branch at Costys
Line so up the said Branch to the head line then by the 50
line to the Beginning it being eighty Acres more or less to
him and his heirs forever.

I give and bequeath unto my son Edmund Doyle the Land
where he now lives beginning at the mouth of a little Branch
so up the said Branch to John Bennets Line then along the
said Line to Sarasota Branch down the said Branch to the
Beginning it being eighty Acres more or less to him and his
heirs forever.

Item I give unto my loving Wife Elizath Doyle the the plantation
whereon I now live and all the Land thereunto belonging
it being two hundred & fifty Acres more or less I give it my said
Wife during her life or widowhood after her decease or marriage
then to be sold to the highest bidder & the effects thereof to be
equally divided between my five sons namely Daniel William
Josiah Jacob and John Doyle to them and their Heirs

Item I give unto my Daughter Darcas Burr one feather bed &
furniture on the consideration that her Husband Hardy
Burr pay unto my executor twenty five shillings to the
use of the Estate to her & her Heirs

Item I give unto my Daughter Elizath Doyle twenty five shilling
current Money to her & her Heirs

Item I give unto my Wife Elizath all the remainder of my Estate
Goods and Chattels both within Doors and without during her
life or widowhood and after her decease or marriage then to be
equally divided between all my Children lastly I do Ordain

equally divided between all my children leaving 500 of which
my Wife Eliz^a Doyle and my son Hardy Doyle whole Sole
Executors of this my last Will and Testament revoking disannul-
ling all other Wills heretofore made by me In Witness
whereof I have hereunto set my Hand Seal this the 22 Day of Feb^r
1762.
