my Last Will & Testament in manner & form following
I give & Bequeath to my Sister Sarah Crocker all
my Land lying on Buckhorn Swamp in the County
aforesaid which was bought of Nottonway Indians
to her & her Heirs forever but if my said Sister
Sarah dies without an Heir I give the said Land
to my Sister Mary to her & her Heirs forever
I give & Bequeath to Mary Hundred & daughter of Samuel
Hundred & two Hundred & twenty of Virginia
I do constitute & appoint my loving Father Benjamin
Crocker whole & sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand &
that the Day & Year first above Written
