Will and Testament in manner and form following to wit

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Dupree one Featherbed of fur-
niture to her own choice and one large brass Kettle and one Copper Tea Kettle and
my smallest Iron pot and four Pewter Dishes and one Plate and six spoons
and one Flax Wheel and one Cotton wheel and two pair Cotton Cards and one Iron
bowed Chair and all my wearing clothes and all the spun Yarn that shall be found
in my possession at my Death and half my Ready Money and one large Bible
and two Pewter basins and six Glass Bottles &c. &c. and his heirs forever

I give and Bequeath to my Grandson Henry Warren Son of Michael Warren
the other half of my Money as mentioned and two Cows and Calves and one Filly called
Beg and one Saddle and Bridle and one Bucknear Gun

I give and bequeath to my Son Michael Warren all the rest of my Stock unmentioned
and all the rest of my Estate that I have not before disposed of to him and his Heirs forever
My Will and desire is that my Estate shall not be Appraised And last I do appoint
my well beloved Friends Henry Bittle and Son Michael Warren my whole and sole
Executors of this my last Will and testament disannulling all other Wills and do declare
this to be my only true Will. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
this 13th Day of January 1781

and two Quarter hawns and six Glaze Cottles John and his heirs for ever
I give and bequeath to my Son Henry Warren Son of Michael Warren
the other half of my Money unmentioned and two Cows and Calves and one Filly called
Beg. and one Saddle and Bridle and one Buckner Gun

Now I give and bequeath to my Son Michael Warren all the rest of my Stock unmentioned
and all the rest of my Estate that I have not before disposed of to him and his Heirs forever
My Will and desire is that my Estate shall not be Appraised And last I do Appoint
my well beloved Friends Henry Bittle and Son Michael Warren my whole and sole
Executors of this my last Will and testament disannulling all other Wills and do declare
