A Copy of a will In the name of God Amen I being
sick in body but of good memory thanks be to almighty god & willing to
rememberance the uncertain state of this Transitory life & that all
flesh must yield to death & when it shall please God to call do make
make constitute & declare this my last will & Testament in manner
& for in following revoking & annulling by these presents all & every last testament
& Testaments with & without benefit of time made & declared either
by word or writing & this is taken & may for my last will & Testament with
none other & first being present & sound from my heart for only gods part may
legibly, desiring forgiveness, for the same I give & commit my soul unto
almighty God my saviour & redemption whom by the merits of Jesus Christ
I trust I believe assuredly through Christ to be saved & that my soul with
my body at a general day of the Resurrection shall arise again with
Joy & through the merits of Christs death & passion to enjoy & inherit the
Kingdom of heaven prepared for his Elect & chosen & my body to be buried
in the burial, in such a place where it shall please my Executors hereafter

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named to appoint I have to say first that all my debts & dues as follows
 right of conscience to any person persons whatsoever to be satisfied, after my
 decease by my Executors hereafter named. I then I give & bequeath my wife
 what it shall please God to live for the bringing up of the children my wife
 & dea is that Margaret Glover the wife of George Glover, shall have as long
 as shee continues my Widow I bestow with advise of the Judge &
 administrator my share after the youngest child come of age to for
 to share Equall in all it shall please God to live so I commit you all
 to the the protection of almighty god I shall be glad for some of my
 Brothers to come here Jonathan Glover is one & the first Samuel
