Value of Twelve Pounds Ten Shillings, One feather &

furniture to the Value of Eight Pounds & Pewter to the

Value of two Pounds current Money & one young Grey

to her, her heirs & assigns for ever

Item I have Devise & bequeath unto my beloved wife Sarah Blun
the use & Labour of my Slaves Tom & Beek during the natural

but at her Decease my will is that the above Slave Tom
Decend to my son Thomas his heirs &c. & that other Slave
Beek Decend to my Daughter Mary to her her heirs & assigns
for ever.

Item & Now my will is that all the rest & residue of my Estate of
what nature or kind so ever after all Just Debts & Legacies paid
may decend to my sd son Thomas his heirs & assigns and I do
appoint my wife Sarah & my son Thomas Executors
of this my Last will & Testament In Witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 16 day of
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life of her the said Sarah as also I give her one feather bed
& Furniture to the Value of Eight & Twenty Pounds Current money
but at her Decease my will is that the above Slave Tom
Descend to my son Thomas his heirs &c & that other Slave
Beck Descend to my Daughter Mary to her heirs & assigns
for ever.

Item & Now my will is that all the rest & residue of my Estate of
what nature or kind so ever after all Just Debts & Legacies paid
may descend to my s^d son Thomas his heirs & assigns and I do
appoint my s^d wife Sarah & my son Thomas Executors &c
of this my Last will & Testament In Witnes whereof I
have hereunto set my hand & affixed my Seal this 6 day of
January 1758.
