Item I Give & bequeath to my son James Poppe one shilling

Item I Give & bequeath to my son Lazarus Poppe one shilling

Item I Give & bequeath my daughter Martha Johnson one shilling

Item I Give to my daughter Mary Parrot one shilling

Item I give to my granddaughter Mary Parrot a negro girl named
Joan who she hath to her mother in her lifetime

Item I Give and bequeath to my son Henry Poppe all the residue of my
estate that is to say the plantation wherein I now live containing
two hundred & fifty acres of land also two negroes Raul & Ephraim
also all my home cattle large & small household furniture together with the crops
growing on the aforesaid plantation

I also appoint my loving son Henry Poppe to be my whole & sole executor
of this my last will & Testament In witness whereof I have here-
unto set my hand & affixed my seal this 22 day of May 1766

Mem I give to my granddaughter Eliza Cary a negro girl named
Joan which I lent to her mother in her lifetime
