I Give to my i Stephen John Brown Ten pounds Current money and one
third part of all the residue of my estate both real and personal and
to the heirs of his Body lawfully begotten for ever and in case the said
John Brown should die without such heir then my Will and desire
is that my sister Olive Brown should have the use of the said Ten
Pounds and the said one third part of my estate during her life and
after her decease I give the said Ten pounds and the said one third
part of my estate to my two Brothers Joseph and Jesse to be equally
divided betwixt them and to their heirs for ever

I Give and bequeath to my two Brothers Joseph and Jesse all the
remainder part of my estate both real and personal after my
just debts and Legacies paid to be equally divided betwixt them
share and share alike and to their heirs for ever

It is my Will that my Executors hereafter named shall not be
oblig'd to give security nor have any appraisement

I do appoint my Brothers Joseph and Jesse and my Brothers
in law John Brown whole and sole Executors of this my last will
