Also I give him my negroe girl slave named Phebe to him

and his heirs forever

Item I give devise and bequeath unto my daughter Rebecca

Johnson two feather beds and furniture one large iron

pot two pewter dishes half a doz plates one large basin

also I give her my negroe woman slave named Pate to her



and her heirs forever

Item I give devise and bequeath unto my daughter Rebecca two feather beds and furniture one large round table two painted dishes six plates one chest of drawers and one cruet set to her and her heirs forever

All the remainder part of my estate of what nature or kind soever I give to be equally divided between my four children viz. Henry James H. Francis and Rebecca & lastly I appoint my loving wife Elizabeth to sell to this my last will and testament my home & dwelling all other debts herebefore owing their duty to be my last will and testament and sell the same of the 8<sup>th</sup> month called August 1765
