In the name of God amen I James Haisty of Southampton County being  
weak of body but of perfect sound mind & memory do hereby  
give forth make constitute & appoint this to be my last will & testament  
declaring & allowing all other wills heretofore made by me

I Give & bequeath to my son Benjamin Haisty the plantation  
situate in the county of Southampton & all the lands & tenements therein & all the  
goods & chattels & the same to be his & his heirs & assigns forever

Item I Give & bequeath to my son Robert Wainwright the plantation whereon he  
now lives four hundred acres of land belonging to the same four feather  
bed & furniture to him & his heirs forever who has now in possession

Item I Give & bequeath to my son James Wainwright the plantation whereon I  
now live four hundred & three acres of land belonging to the same  
four feather bed & furniture to him & his heirs forever

Item I Give & bequeath to my son John Wainwright one feather bed &  
furniture which he has in possession to him & his heirs forever

Item I Give unto my beloved wife Elizabeth Wainwright all the remaining  
part of my estate of what nature outlives her ever endearing of her  
natural life & after her decease to be equally divided among my  
children as follows Elizabeth Sarah Isabel Elizabeth  
Joshua Matthew Moses John & James Wainwright their heirs  
forever

Item I Do appoint my two sons John & James executors of this my last
