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Pitchin In the Name of God Amen I James Kitching
James of the County of Southampton being of sound and
well disposing Mind & Memory thanks be to God for it do
make & Ordain this my Last Will & Testament in manner
and forme as followeth revoking all other Wills by
me Afsigned heretofore.

- first I give and devise unto my son Joseph Kitching the
Plantation whereof I now live with 175 Acres of Land.
secondly I give & devise unto my son Benjamin Kitching 175
Acres of Land Called Bryants Plantation
thirdly I give and Devise unto my Son James & Matthew Kitching
all my Land lying on the North side of Black Creek
at the Age of twenty years Old.
fourthly I give and Devise unto my Daughter Matthew one Huffer
and thirty Shillings to be made out of my Estate.

for I give and devise unto my son Joseph Kitching the
Plantation whereof I now live with 175 Acres of Land.

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Secondly I give & devise unto my son Benjamin Kitching 175
Acres of Land called Bryants Plantation.

Thirdly I give and Devise unto my son James Matthew Kitching
all my land lying on the North side of Black Creek
at the Age of twenty years old.

Fourthly I give and Devise unto my Daughter Matthew one Heiffer
and thirty Shillings to be made out of my Estate.

Fifthly I give and devise unto my Daughter Lydia one Heiffer.

Sixthly I give and devise unto my Daughter Mary one young
Heiffer more then she have in Custody.

Seventhly I give unto my Daughter Ann one Feather Bed and
one three year old Heiffer.

part of my Estate also the Use and Labour of my Negro Fellow
Simon for the Term of seven years

And I give & devise all the Rest & Remainder of my Estate of what
Nature or kind soever to be Equally divided Betwixt my
Children William Elizabeth Christian Patience and
Mildred

Lastly I constitute my well beloved James Jordan Scott my sole
and Sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament
