Item my Will is nobody shall Heir any part of my Estate during
my Wifes life only my Land to my Son John at the Age
twenty one years I likewise do appoint my loving Wife whole
and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament whereunto

for my Daughters Mary Wright to Have the said Land
from my Will is nobody shall have any part of my Estate during
my Wifes life only my Land to my Son John at the Age
twenty one years I Likewise do appoint my loving Wife and
and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament whereunto
I have set my hand and Seal December ye 25. 1761.
