 weak of body but sound in mind and memory do make and ordain
 his last Will and Testament in manner and form as
 follows - To Wit

Item I give the use of the plantation whereon I now live to my
 loving Wife Sarah during her Widowhood and in like manner I
 give my Wife the labour of four Negroes Vizt Sam Lucy Judith
 & Lewis with two feather beds and furniture Twenty Barrels of
 Indian Corn five hundred pounds of Bacon my Roan Horse her
 Riding Saddle and Bridle with one half of my Kitchen furniture
 at the Apprais'd Value

Item I Give and bequeath to my Son Joseph Wombwell the
 land and plantation he and a plantation lately purchased
 of Arthur Stallenman containing One Hundred and thirty acres be
 the same more or less to hold to him and his heirs for ever and at
 the death or Marriage of my Wife (his Mother) I Give to my
 said Son Joseph & to his Heirs for ever my Negro Man Sam

Item I Give and bequeath to my Son Jesse Wombwell the Land
 and plantation whereon I now dwell containing Two Hundred &
 Eighty five acres be the same more or less after the death or Marriage
 of his Mother to hold to him and his heirs for ever I Give to my
 said Son my Cyder Still

Item I Give and bequeath to my Son Joshua Wombwell four
 Negroes Vizt Lucy & Lewis with their increase to hold to him
 & his heirs for ever

Item I Give to my Daughter Nancy Wombwell Twenty pounds

Item I Give to my daughter Nancy Woman of Sundry pounds
Cash to be raised out of my estate

last Will and Testament Witnesses my hand and Seal This six^{teenth}
