I give and bequeath unto my son John Baron the land and plantation whereon I now live together with its appurtenances and likewise a still and its appurtenances and also a negro boy named Isaac and a feather bed and furniture of his own choosing a copper Kettle and a large pot and half my hogs ~~that~~ I shall have at that time and all the sheep undermilk and all the stone and glass ware of all kinds and also all the Cyder Barrells and hog heads of all kinds and I likewise give all my Tobacco dried or standing at that time and half my stock that shall be standing or gathered at that time to him and his heirs forever.

I give and bequeath unto my grand child Phoebe All Baron all my pewter of all kinds and spere mortar and pestle and also a brass kettle and a looking glass and a coffee pot and the ware belonging to it to her and her heirs forever.

iron pots and hawks and also a three gallon stone jug to him
and his heirs forever

and plantation wherein I now live together with its appurtenances
and likewise a still and the appurtenances and also a new
iron named Isaac and a feather bed and furniture of his
choosing a copper kettle and a large pot and half my haws-
ers I shall have at that time and all the sheep under me
and all the stone and glass ware of all kinds and also all
the Cyder Barrells and hogsheds of all kinds and likewise
give all my tobacco-pipe or standing at that time and half
my shop that shall be standing or gathered at that time to him
and his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my grand child Phebe All
Barion all my pewter of all kinds and spate mortar and pestle
and also a brass kettle and a looking glass and a coffee pot and
the ware belonging to it to her and her heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Anne Remond
a flat hatchet and an small iron pot to her and her heirs for
ever

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Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Hannah Petman
a negro girl named Cila and also a negro boy named Jack
providing paying of me John Barrow Senior one pound six shillings
to her and her heirs for ever also a large bible

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Martha Fugate
a negro woman named Venus and her inheritance to her and her
heirs for ever

Item I leave my negro man will to be sold at public sale
and I give two thirds of that money to my son John Barrow
and the other one third to my son Daniel Barrow and I bequeath
the other half of my crop unmentioned to my son Daniel Barrow
to they and their heirs for ever

Item I leave my negro mares all the rest of my estate unmen-
tioned of what kind saever to be sold to the highest bidder and the
money arising from the sale to be equally divided between my
three sons William Barrow and Daniel Barrow

Lastly I do appoint my son John Barrow and Benjamin some
my whole and sole Executors of this my last will and tes-
tament discharging all former wills by me made I do hereunto
unto set my hand and affixed my seal this
tenth day of July 1771
