fore made by me

Them, I give to my Mother Clara Brown all my Estate that I am now in possession
of after my debts are paid and as she dies her share to me until her Decease I
give the whole both real and personal of what nature and kind soever to her and to her
disposal forever. I do appoint my Mother my whole and sole Executor of this my
last will In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 23^d day

At the Court held for the County of Southampton the 6th day of August 1781
