In the name of God amen the 15 day of October 1772 John
Hines of the County of Southampton & parish of Mottoway being Sick and
weak but in perfect mind and memory thanks be to God for the same makes
this my last will and testament in manner & form following
I give and bequeath to my son Peter Hines one half of the land whereon I now
live including the house which is to be divided by a line running from the river
to the back line after the death of my wife also one young bay Mare station
and his heirs forever

I give & bequeath to my son Joshua Hines the other half of the land I now live on
after the death of my wife also I give my said son Joshua the full parcel that
that the old mare shall bring to him and his heirs forever

I give and bequeath to my sons I said & I mentioned of them one brother
and I provided to them and their heirs forever

165 I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Hines one hundred acres of land
lying between Richard Parker land & William Hines land to him & his
heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my son Richard Hines one hundred acres of land
lying between Richard Parker land & William Hines land to him & his
heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my son John Hines one Negro Dick John & Moll
to him and his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my son William Hines three Negroes Moll George
& Judith to him and his heirs forever

Item I give to my son Thomas Hines one shilling

Item I leave to my loving wife Elizabeth Hines the use of the plantation whereon I now
live together with all the remainder of my estate of all kinds whatsoever
during her natural life & after her death if there is any estate left my Will
and desire is that it may be equally divided amongst my children likewise
I do constitute make & ordain my wife Elizabeth Hines my executor of this
my last will & testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand & Seal the day and year first above written
