I give and bequeath to my son James Johnson the plantation  
whereon I now live to him and his heirs and if he dies with-  
out issue to my grandson Shadrach son of Josiah David  
half the value of the land to my grand son Rancis Johnson  
the son of Thomas Johnson I give and bequeath to my son  
James Johnson one horse Bridle and saddle one feather  
bed and furniture and five head of cattle  
and one head of sheep and seven head of hogs I give and be-  
queath all the rest of my estate to my well beloved wife
