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Item My desire is that all the Remainder part of my Estate of all kinds whatsoever should be sold and the Money arising from the Sale to be Equally divided between my Seven Children, Patience, Elizabeth, Sarah, Janet, William, Ann & Foster. I likewise constitute make and Ordain William Foster and my Son Janet Morgan my sole and sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal This the 15th Day of March One thousand seven hundred and seventy five.
