In the name of God Amen The Twentieth day of July One thousand seven hundred and seventy three I John Benson of this parish of St. Lukes in the County of Southampton being very sick but of perfect sense and memory thanks be to God do make this my last Will and Testament

I Give and bequeath my Soul to e Almighty God that gave it me assurance and certain hope of a Glorious Resurrection unto eter-
nal life and my body to be buried at the discretion of my Wors here after mentioned

I Give and bequeath the following tracts of Land to William Benson
Sen^r One certain tract of Land lying and being in the County of Orange & Grandville on the North and South side of the River Two Thousand one hundred acres be the same more or less Also two certain tracts of Land lying upon the head of Fishing Creek in Bull County Virginia hundred Acres be the same more or less to him and his heirs forever

Item I Give unto William Blunt Senr. one tract of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton The plantation whereon William Morgan now lives Five Hundred Acres Also one half tract of land in Brimswick County Two Hundred Acres be the same more or less to him and his heirs for ever

Item I Give and bequeath to William Blunt Senr. the following Negroes viz. Tom Harry York Frank, Israel, Perry, Moses, David, Jacob, Simon, Tom, Jack, Ben, Jack, James Hannah Cato Lucy Sal Joan, Isaac, Evan Cato Evan (Tmey) Patience Osten Lucy Edoy Solomon (Tmey) and their increase to him and his heirs for ever

Item I Give and bequeath to William Blunt All my Stock of Horses Cattle Hogs & Sheep to him and his heirs for ever my desire is after all my just debts is paid the remainder part to William Blunt Senr. if any I do make and constitute William Blunt Senr. and John Blunt my whole & sole Executors of this my last will and Testament In
