I give & recommend myself to the mercy of Almighty God that
giver of my body to be buried at the discretion of my Exors here
after mentioned & unto what worldly Goods it shall please God
to bestow on me I do give of them in manner following
Item I leave to my loving wife Honour the sum of my Manors

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Plantations including one third part of three hundred & thirty
four acres of Land for & during her Natural Life or Widow
hood & after her death or Marriage I give the said Land
to my son George & his Heirs forever or to be he then
in his own life of twenty one years but if my son George
shall not live to attain to the age of twenty one years, then
I give the said Land to my son Thomas & to his Heirs forever

Item I give the remaining two third parts of my Land whereon I
now live to be equally divided when my son William comes to the
Age of twenty one year between my son William & Thomas
to them and their Heirs forever

Item I give to my son Moses one Hundred & fifty Acres of Land, more
or less that I thought of this Day to him & his Heirs forever
I give to my son Moses ^{ten 1000.00.} current money to be raised out of my
Estate

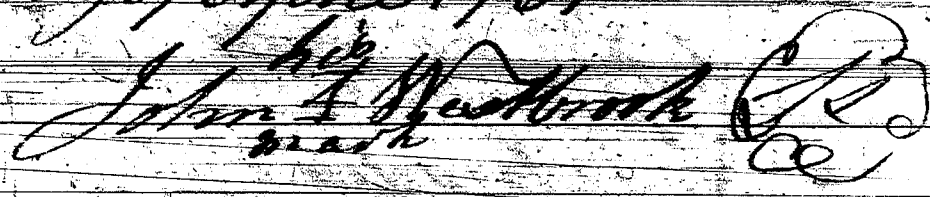
Item I give to my son James one Negro man called Little Peter
to him & his Heirs forever

Item I give to my son Elias one Negro man named Jack to him
of his Heirs forever, I give unto my son Thomas my Negro
woman name Florie to him & His Heirs forever

Item I give to my son Burwell my Negro Girl Doll to him & His
Heirs forever — Item I leave to my loving Wife Harriett
the use of Negro man called Great Peter for & during her
Natural Life & Widowhood & after her Marriage or death
to be sold to the highest Bidder & the money therefrom
arising to be equally divided among all my Children
that shall be then living

Item I leave all the Remainder of my Estate after my Just
Debts & the payment of my said to be ~~discontinued~~ ^{discontinued} &
to remain in my Love Hands to bring up my
Children until as they shall attain to the Age of
Twenty one years and as fast as they shall come to the

age that my Estate shall pay them of Respectively
 in an equal Proportion according to the Value of the
 Appoint Reserving to my Wife and all Childs Part
 out of the same and I do appoint my loving Wife
 Honour my loving Brother James Hamsey Executors
 of this my last will & Testament hereby Revoking
 all other wills formerly by me made & do declare
 this to be my Last Will and Testament
