to her and her heirs for ever

Item

I Give to my Grand Daughter Elizabeth Dawson Everett a Negro
Girl named Patt to Her & Her heirs for ever

Item

I Give to my Grand Daughter Polly Pope a Negro Girl named
Patt to her and her heirs for ever

Item

I Give to my son Simon the land and plantation whereon I live
to him and his heirs for ever the rent or profit to go to my estate
till he shall arrive to age of Twenty one years

Item

I Give all the remainder of my estate after my debts is paid to
my son Simon and Daughters Sarah and Sennet to be equally
divided between them when my son Simon arrive to age above
mentioned, to them and their heirs for ever

Item

I Give my Will and desire is that the use of my estate Land
included be for the support maintainance and education

mentioned, to them and their heirs forever

Item I give my Will and desire is that the use of my estate Land included be for the support maintainance and education of my said son Simon and Daughter Sarah and Jennet til my son Simon arrive to age above mentioned

Item Also my Will and desire is that my Executors at their discretion do either sell all or any part of my estate my negroes accepted or to rent the land and hire the negroes thereon ~~to keep the whole estate together on the land as they shall think most to advantage until my son Simon do arrive to age and the profits to go as above mentioned~~

Item I do make and ordain my son in law David Garrison and my friend John Wilkinson my Executors of this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have set my hand and affixed my seal the day and year first above written
