~~son & wife~~ county and millway parish being sick and weak in body but
of sound and perfect memory Thanks be to almighty god
make and ordain this to be my last will and testament in
manner and form as followeth ~~and~~ after my just debts
funeral expenses are paid and discharged the rest of my
worldly estate which god of his mercy hath bestowed on me
I dispose thereof as followeth.

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Rivers that
silk crape enough for a gown

I give to my daughter Sarah Steward the labour of my right
girl Lurecia till my daughter Fanny is of the age of twenty
one years or married

I give to my daughter Lucy Edmunds half a dozen pearls

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Fanny Nicholson one mulatto boy called Henry and one negro girl called Lurinda of blacky friends summt Henry also one feather bed & furniture of eight pounds value one set of furniture consisting of three dishes two flat dishes one small basin one box in plates one box hand mirror spoons one gilt trunk of twelve shillings value one set of five shillings value also one young horse for saddle and bridle also one small looking glass of about twelve or fourteen shillings value

I give and bequeath unto my dear and loving wife Sarah Nicholson the labour of my mulatto man and the labour of my mulatto woman ~~for~~ during her natural life I also give to my aforesaid wife Sarah the labour of my negro man Thinks and my negro woman Kate and the use of all them or any of them during the time of her widowhood I also one feather bed and furniture to her use

I give All the reversion and remainder of my estate I give & bequeath unto my son Joshua Nicholson

I do also constitute and appoint my aforesaid wife Sarah my aforesaid son Joshua to be my will and sole executor of this my last will and testament to fulfill the same fully without delay and performed according to the true intent and meaning thereof

my affect for Joshua to be married and
thus my last will and testament to be
read and performed according to the
terms thereof

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Item I nominate and appoint Col. Powell Edwards, Mary Nathan
Kells as overseers to see this will well performed & completed as
written my hand and seal this twentieth day of September one
Thous and seven hundred and sixty two
