Rachel & Kim also one hundred and fifty acres of land joining William
Thomas land that he bought of Thomas B. Hunt to her & her heirs
for ever

I Give bequeath & devise unto my daughter Breda my negro
man Chanu & Judah also forty pounds current money of Virginia
when she is married to her & her heirs for ever

I Bequeath & devise unto my son William negroes Sarah
Samuel & Bob also after my wife's decease the plantation & all the

Then I give my negro
man Chanu & Judah also for the current money of Virginia
when she is married to her husband for ever

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Item I Bequeath & assign unto my son William negro Sarah

remainder of my lands to him & his heirs for ever

Lastly my will & desire is that after my wife decease my whole estate

equally divided between my three children I do also appoint my
wife Elizabeth & my loving brother Jacob Vick & Arthur Vick
