Item, I do appoint Joshua Miniard & Eliza Mackey my whole & Soul Exors. to this my last Will & Testament disannulling & revoking all & every other Will or Wills writings or demands In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & fixt my Seal this 30th day of Sept. 1779.
