I bequeath & commit my Soul into the hands of the Almighty God who gave it hoping for Eternal Life and my Body to the ground to be buried in a deciant manner at the discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned & as for my worldly Estate which it hath pleased God to bless me with, I dispose of in the following manner, Viz:

Item, I give & bequeath unto Joshua Miniard one Negro Man named Mingo unto him & his heirs forever.

Item, I give & bequeath unto Eliz<sup>a</sup>. Mackey all the remainder part of my estate after paying my just debts & Fun<sup>u</sup>ral expences her & her heirs forever.
