of Body but of Sound Mind & Memory do make this my last Will
& Testament in Manner of Form as follows I give & bequeath
unto my Cousin James Harris Son of Robert Harris the Plantation
whereon I now live of two hundred Acres of Land thereunto belonging
be the same more or less to the said James Harris of his Heirs for
ever I give unto the said James Harris one Negro Woman called
Jenny to him & Heirs forever
I give unto James Harris Son of Edward Harris one Negro Man
called Balaam to him & his Heirs forever
I give unto Matthew Harris Son of Robert Harris one Negro
Girl called Patt to him & his Heirs forever
I give unto John Harris Son of Robert Harris one Negro Girl
called Olive to him & his Heirs forever I give unto William Harris
Son of George Harris one Negro Girl called Rose to him & his
Heirs forever I give unto James Harris Son of James Harris
One Case of Pistols & Malsters if I do appoint John Dunkley Joseph
Jones & William Jones Executors of this my last Will & Testament
