I desire that all my stock of what kind so ever be kept on the

each boy taking their proportion as they come of age the remainder
to be given to Benjamin it is also my direction that the negroes given
my wife her life after her death with there increase be equally
divided amongst my 3 youngest children or there survivors

of them I do appoint my wife Elizabeth my good friend Miss Blunck
