and title to the land and plantation whereon I now live and
one Bay Horse called price one sow and seven piggs and eight
sheats to him and his heirs forever

I Give and bequeath to Polly Bryant a negro Woman named
Sall and in case she die before she arrive to age to go and
descend to her sister, Ann Bryant, and her heirs forever

I Give and bequeath to my loving Daughter Elizabeth
Sugar Bynum the land and plantation I purchast of
Richard Blows and negroes a Man Harry Boys Abram & Jack
and a Girl Sall and all the residue and remainders of my
estate after my debts and legacies paid, to her and her
heirs forever

My Will and desire is that if my Daughter above mentioned
die without heirs of her Body lawfully begotten that this
whole estate devised to her be equally divided between my
Brothers and Sisters William Bynum Benjamin Bynum
& Eliza Williamson and Sarah Bynum
