of Virginia to be paid her at her marriage or at the age of
twenty one years

I Give and Bequeath to my son Joel Pope five hundred

Item I Give to my daughter Phoebe Pope five pound, current money
of Virginia to be paid her at her marriage or at the age of
Twenty one Years.

Item I Give and Bequeath to my son Joel Pope five pound current
money of Virginia to be paid him at the age of Twenty one Year.

Item I Give and Bequeath to my son Nathan Pope and his heirs for
ever the plantation wherein I live & all the land thereunto be-
longing after his or their decease.

Item I Give to my son Richard Pope & his heirs for ever the necessary

also five pound current money of Virginia to be paid to him at
the age of Twenty one Years.
