 ing one hundred & ten Acres of Land to my beloved Wife Sarah
 Davis during her Natural Life and at decease I give Devise
 and bequeath the afo^d one hundred and ten Acres of Land
 to my Son Charles Davis to him & to his Heirs & Assigns forever.

I hereby give devise & bequeath unto my Son Edmund Davis my Negro Girl
 Dianah to him and to his Heirs & Assigns forever.

* I hereby give the Use & Labour of my other two Negroes John & Jane to
 my beloved Wife Sarah during her natural life & to all
 the best & residue of my Estate it being of What nature or
 kind soever after all Just Debts and Legacies paid I leave
 after her Death to be Equally Divided between my Wife
