Impumes whereas I have before given by Deed of Gift unto my sons Tho^s Butte, Benjⁿ
Butte, John Butte, William Butte & James Butte Lands & slaves & other things which they now
have in possession I do by this my Last Will & Testament Bequeath & Confirm the Gifts of Deeds
to them & their Heirs forever.

Item, I give & Bequeath to my daughter Lucy Butte the Slaves following Harriet, Deborah, Hannah &
Mary to her & her heirs for ever I likewise Give to my s^d Daughter Lucy after the death of my
Wife one Negro Boy named Ted to her & her heirs for ever.

Item, I give & Bequeath to my Daughter Molly Butte the slaves following Doll, Liddy, & Susan, & Sarah
also one Feather Bed & Furniture to her & her heirs forever.

Item, I give & Bequeath to my Daughter Betty Butte the Slaves following Jack & Dennis the Furni-
ture also one Feather Bed & Furniture to her & her Heirs forever.

Item, I give & Bequeath to my son Daniel Butte after the Death of my Wife the Plantation where
on I now live containing four hundred Acres to him & his heirs forever I also give to my said son

Daniel after the Death of my wife the Slaves & other things hereunder mentioned, Anthony
Beck, Sam^l, & Lamona also one Silver Tankard, two head of Cattle one horse & saddle & all my
Household & Kitchen Furniture which is not before given away to him & his Heirs forever.

Item, I give & Bequeath to my son William Butte one Little Negro named Neron which negro I
bought & named in the Deed of Gift I made to him to him & his Heirs forever.
