In the Name of God Amen, I Richard Kirby of the Parish of Vottonay County of Southampton being in perfect health of sound & disposing mind and memory do make & declare this for my last will & Testament & nothing at former will by me made in manner & form following

First I give & bequeath to my Son Benjamin Kirby two hundred Acres of Land whereon he now lives to him & his Heirs forever Also I give & bequeath to my Son Benjamin five Shillings Lawfull Currency of Virginia to be raised & paid out of my Estate to him his Heirs forever

Secondly I give & bequeath to my Daughter Susanna Clifton one Negro Girl named Lucy to her & her Heirs forever Also I give & bequeath to my Daughter Susanna Clifton five Shillings Lawfull Currency of Virginia to be raised & paid out of my personal Estate to her & her Heirs forever

Thirdly I give & bequeath to my Son Silas two hundred Acres of Land whereon he now lives to him & his Heirs forever Also I give & bequeath to my Son Silas five Shillings Lawfull Currency of Virginia to be raised & paid out of my personal Estate to him & his Heirs forever Also I give & bequeath to my Son Silas after my death one Negro Boy named Daniel to him & his Heirs forever

Fourthly I give & bequeath to my Daughter Pally Pond after my Death one Negro Girl named Pleasant to her & her Heirs forever Also I give & bequeath to my Daughter Pally five Shillings Lawfull Currency of Virginia to be raised & paid out of my personal Estate to her & her Heirs forever

I hereby give & bequeath to my Son Rich<sup>d</sup> Kirby all my Lands lying & being on the South side of the Main Road together with all my Vines & Peach Orchard one Shill of all that appertains thereto to him & his heirs forever I also give & bequeath to my Son Richard Kirby one third part of my personal Estate to him & his heirs forever I also make & ordain my Son Rich<sup>d</sup> Kirby the sole Executor of this last will & Testament

I hereby give & bequeath all my Lands lying & being on the North side of the Main Road to Gethse with one Negro boy named Cyck to be Equally Divided between my Sons Thomas Kirby & Miles Kirby to them & their heirs forever I also give & bequeath to my Son Tho<sup>s</sup> of Miles Kirby each one third of my personal Estate to them & their heirs forever In witness whereof I have hereon to set my hand & seal this twenty fourth day of Feb<sup>y</sup> one thousand seven hundred & Eighty The within writing was signed sealed & published & declared by the Testator in presence of Ben<sup>t</sup> Stewart & Rich<sup>d</sup> Kirby & John Kirby Henry <sup>his</sup> <sup>ordain</sup> <sub>mark</sub>

personal Estate to them & their heirs forever. In witness whereof I have hereon  
to set my hand & seal this twenty fourth day of Feb<sup>r</sup> one thousand seven
