June 19 1763 Southampton County, Spanish of No. Hony
In the name of god Amen I Robert Carr now being in
perfect good sense and memory but calling to mind that all
men must die I make this my last will and in manner

as followeth Viz

First I bequeath my soul to god that gave it in the
name of Jesus Christ and may I hope to be buried in a
decent and christian like manner as for what estate I have
I bequeath to endow me with in the following manner
Viz

I give and bequeath to my eldest son Robert Carr the
plantation situate in his town and two hundred thirty
five acres adjoining thereto also one hundred & twenty five
acres of land lying in Southampton County on Piney Key
to him and his heirs forever

I give and bequeath to my youngest son John Carr the
plantation situate in his town and one hundred & fifty

acres of land belonging Thacker also two hundred twenty
 five acres of land lying in Isle of Wight some belonging
 to and of ~~the same estate~~ ^{the same estate} the west side of the
 Galben branches from the banks of the river for twenty five
 acres of land lying on Passy bridge to have this to
 forever In case my son John Carr should die without issue
 lawfully begotten his lands to fall to his four sisters Ann
 Jones Elizabeth Johnson Rebecca Carr and Grace Carr
 to them and their heirs to be equally divided

I now give and bequeath to my son John Carr one Still Cup
and Warmer reserving that my son Robert Carr shall have
the use of her to still his own liquor in case my son
John Carr die without issue the still to fall to my son
Robert Carr.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Rebecca Carr one basin and
cup one feather bed and furniture & one tor dish one basin
and 3 plates and one chest one silver snuff box a pistol.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Grace Carr one feather bed &
furniture one cup and saucer one chest one quater dish one basin
and 3 plates.

I give to my four daughters Ann Maria Maria & Johnson

Rebecca Carr and Grace Carr with ~~the same~~ ^{the same} equally
& divided amongst them.

Item I give and bequeath to my loving wife Sarah
feather bed and furniture her choice of all the beds & basins
and all the remainder of my moveable estate ~~my~~ ^{my} ~~to be~~
~~divided~~ ^{to be} ~~amongst~~ ^{equally divided amongst} the children.

I leave my two sons Robert Carr and John Carr full and sole

executors of this my last will and testament
