in good health of body & sound mind & perfect memory do hereby
this my last will & testament in manner following first I
Command my soul to God who gives me & secondly my
body to the earth to be decently buried the executors hereafter
mentioned I for what estate I have disposed of as follows
I give unto my son Thomas Hart 50 acres of land now or late
lying on the North side of Tatters branch running up Biggs
Branch to Robert. All his share live to him & his heirs forever
I give unto my son Jesse Hart the plantation whereon I now
live with all the remainder of my land to him & his heirs forever
My will & desire is that my wife Robert Hart may have my
young mare as she shall be appraised & money to return to my
estate whatever my will & desire is that my negro boy & girl
may be sold the money to return to my estate

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I give unto my daughter Eliza Hart 20/ to be paid out of my estate
I give unto my daughter Sarah Hart 20/ to be paid out of my estate
I give unto my daughter Mary Hart 20/ to be paid out of my estate
I will & decree that my Just obligacion is that
all the remainder of my Estate of what Nature soever may be
equally divided between my 7 Children that is to say Thos
Hart & Abel Hart & Jeph Hart & Elizabeth Hart & Lucy Hart & Mary
Hart & Sarah Hart Lastly I do hereby appoint my son Jeph
Hart my full & sole exor of this my last will & Testament
revoking all other wills heretofore made by me as Witness my
hand & Seal this 25th day of June 1770
