make and ordain this my last will and Testament that
Imprimis after my funeral expenses are defrayed and just debts paid
I dispose of my worldly goods both real and personal which it hath pleased
almighty God of his infinite mercy and good gifts to bestow on me in the
following manner to wit

I Herby Stand to my loving wife Annema Harrison during her natural
life all my whole Estate both real and personal except my wearing
cloaths so as to be possessed of the use of the same during the said term

I Herby desire my said wife to take care of and bring up all my young children
until such time they are able and capable to do and act for themselves

I Herby desire my said wife may deliver to my son Joseph Harrison all my
wearing cloaths and that they may be his own property

I Herby Give and bequeath to my son William Harrison after my wife's death
this Land the West part of my tract of land whereon I now live the S. to line
divided from the East part of the same in the manner following to wit beginning
at the flat swamp at the mouth of the pasture branch then up the S. Pasture branch
to the head of the same then a straight line with the said Pasture branch

North line of my said land a line between the land that formerly was John Adams
and my said land provided to the S. William lives to have & enjoy If said
arrives to the age 21 years to him the said William Harrison & to his heirs forever
I Herby provide for my said son

cloaths so as to be possessed of the use of the same during the 3^d term
I desire my said wife to take care of and bring up all my young children
until such time they are able and capable to do and act for themselves

I desire my land may devolve to my son Joseph Harrison all my
wearing cloaths and that they may be his own property

I give and bequeath to my son William Harrison after my wife departs
this life the West part of my tract of land in vision I now live the 2^d to be
divided from the East part of the same in the manner following to wit beginning
at the flat swamp at the mouth of the pasture branch then up the S. Pasture branch
to the head of the same then a line with the said Pasture branch to the
North line of my Land a line between the land that formerly was John Adams
and my said land for out deed to the S. William lives to have lawful Issue or
arrives to the age 21 years to him the said William Harrison & to his heirs forever

I give and bequeath to my son Joseph after my said wife
departs this life the East part of my Land being the East part of the same
to him the S. Joseph and to his heirs forever

After my wife departs this life I desire all my personal Estate that can
then be found may be sold for the best price that can be got for the same and the
money arising from the sale thereof to be equally divided betwixt my following
children, David, Oliver, Rebecca, Elizabeth Anne Joseph and Charlotte
Harrison

I Item If either of my sons William or Joseph departs this life under the age of twenty one years and without lawful issue then I give the whole of my tract of land to the surviving brother of them two and to his heirs forever.
 I Item the reason why I do not give my son Solomon Harrison my daughter Hannah Richardson my daughter Mary Harrison and my son Harman Harrison no part of my estate is that I have given them a sufficient part sometime past.

I Item I do constitute and appoint my well beloved friends Edward Lundy and Joshua Nicholson my whole and sole Executors of this my last will and Testament In Witnes whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 19th day of March 1775
