but in case my Brother Holliday Ament never Returns I give the said Money to be
Equally Divided between my three Sisters Joannah Holt Mourning Ament of
Charlotte Ament to them and their Heirs forever And I do hereby constitute &
appoint my Friend Samuel Edmunds to be full Executor of this my last Will &
Testament In Witness whereof I have Recurds set my hand and Affixed my
