East side of the Merry Branch running from Head of the merry
Branch to Greenys Mill, thence down the Meadow Branch to him
and his Heirs forever, provided he pay my Son James five pounds
I give and bequeath the aforesaid Land to my son James and his
Heirs forever on his paying my son Thomas five pounds.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Michael Atkinson the plantation
whereon Snow live and all my Land lying on the west

Children (that is to say) Thomas, James, Ann, Nathan, Celia,
Sarah, Easter, Lucy, Michael, and Priscilla.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Thomas Atkinson all my Land on the
East side of the Merry Branch running from Head of the merry
Branch to Jeremy's Hill, thence down the Meadow Branch to him
and his Heirs forever, provided he pay my son James five pounds
I give and bequeath the aforesaid Land to my son James and his
Heirs forever on his paying my son Thomas five pounds.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Michael Atkinson the plantation
whereon I now live and all my Land lying on the west
side of the merry Branch to him and his Heirs forever
provided he pay my son Nathan five pounds current
money. I do hereby constitute and appoint my loving
Wife and my son Thomas my whole and sole Executors
of this my last will and Testament In Witness whereof
