make & ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner & form following &c
In the first place I give & Bequeath my soul to God & my Body to the Earth
to be decently Buried in a Christian like manner by my Executors &c
hereafter to be mentioned. I give and Bequeath to my Son
Benjamin all my land in Southampton &c Virginia to have & to hold to him
his heirs &c forever &c I also give unto my s^d Son Benjamin the sum of Five

Peter, Donah of leaving the Child (Donah to him) & his heirs forever
 I give & Bequeath to my Son Cordey Clifton the Upper Part of my
 Land (Divided from the lower part by a Line of Marked Trees from the River a-
 up the Meadows to the Hill thence down a Valley to Frank's Branch thence
 down the various Courses of S^d Branch as far as my Land continues to him &
 his heirs forever.

I give & Bequeath to Son Claibourn Clifton all the Lower part of my Land
 from the line above mentioned to Godwines line to him & his heirs forever.

I give & Bequeath to my Daughter Dorothy Harrison One Negro Girl
 named Fanny & her Increase to her & her heirs forever. I also give to my
 Daughter ~~the same~~ Virginia Money to be p^d by my Executors Immediately
 after my Decese.

I give & Bequeath to my Daughter Maria Clifton Two Negroes viz
 Tom & Arney to her & her heirs forever. I also give unto my Daughter Maria
 Two pounds to be p^d in the manner, & as for my Daughter Martha who married
 before Dorothy they have had their share of my Estate except ten shillings
 to Sarah & ten shillings to Mary. Two pounds to Ann & Two pounds to
 Eleanor Virginia Money to be paid in the manner as aforesaid. As for the
 Rest of Estate both Real & Personal, I lend the use thereof to my Wife during her
 Natural Life and after her Decese my devise is that what Estate she leaves

first Estate both Real & Personal, And the use thereof to my Wife During her
Natural Life and after her Death my devise is that what Estate she leaves
may be Equally Divided Between her Children Lawfully born to me that shall
be then alive to them if their Wives be dead and I do appoint my loving Wife
Sarah Weston jointly with my son Benⁿ Weston whose full Execution
Executor of this my Last Will & Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & Affixed my seal this 11th Day of Dec^r 1781 one Thousand
Seven hundred & Twenty Nine.
