now lives on containing by estimation two hundred & fifty Acres being a tract
I purchased of the Kelloway Indians

I give & bequeath unto my Son Henry Davis and his heirs forever after my wife's
death the land & plantation I now live on also one other tract I purchased of my
Son Drury adjoining the same also my two Negroes Sam & Briso provided he
pay to my daughter Mary Ten twenty five pounds to my Daughter Hannah
Davis twenty five pounds & to my Grand Daughter Sarah Long ten pounds
in his own possession of the said Negroes Sam Briso

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Hannah Davis twenty five pounds to be paid by my Son Henry on his being in possession of the above named Negroes.

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Lucy Phillips & her heirs forever my Negro Boy named Peter.

I give and bequeath ^{unto my daughter} Mary Tarver Twenty five pounds to be paid my Son Henry on his getting possession of the above named negroes.

I give and bequeath unto my Granddaughter Sarah Long ten pounds to be paid by my Son Henry on his getting possession of the above mentioned Negroes.

I give and bequeath unto my friend Richard Keen it being for value Received Seventeen Acres of land bounded by his own Charles Holt and John Thorps Land to him and his heirs forever.

I give unto my three grandsons (Sons of Son Drury namely Etheldred Thomas & James Davis forty Shillings to be raised out of my estate.
