to mind the uncertainty of this life and that it is appointed for
all mankind once to die do hereby make constitute and
ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form
following

I Give and bequeath to my wife Elizabeth Drury during
her widowhood all my whole estate after the debts is paid on it to
be equally divided amongst all my Children

I And Lastly Appoint my wife Elizabeth as my
Executor to this my last will and testament assenting and des-
cending to the will and testament by me made above
this to be my last will and testament as witness my hand
and Seal this 10th day of April 1777
