In the Name of God Amen I Thomas Edwards of the Parish of Saint Luke and County
of Southampton, being sick and weak of body but sound mind and memory, thank be to
Almighty God for the same do make and constitute this my last Will and Testament in form and
manner following To wit I give and bequeath unto my Son Gordon and his heirs for ever the land
and plantation which I have bought and taken by purchase and humane and more life
but if he should die without him lawfully begotten of his body; I then give and bequeath the said
land and plantation to my dear Nephew and his heirs for ever. I also give my said son Gordon my bay
mare called Peg and the largest saddle and bridle, one leather bed and furniture, my hunting Gun
and two Barl Brandy which he had of Joseph Washington as his substitute in the Service
I then give and bequeath to my Son Benjamin all the remainder of my land after my wife Ann
is dead and her heirs have been but provided he should die without him lawfully begotten of
his body I give and bequeath the same to my Son Christ an free man for ever I also give my
Son Benjamin one horse which I purchased at Popes vale, and the ~~same~~ smallest saddle
and bridle, one leather bed and furniture, my long Gun, also two barrels brandy and £200 in the
hands of Thomas Staj, in being what he wants to receive from or his substitute in the Service
I then give unto my Daughter Mary an Lincolns hall
I then give unto my Daughter Anne an acre of half an acre of Peckham and Turrenden

public sale and the money arising therefrom be applied by my Executors named
names, to purchase a ~~Marriage~~ ^{Marriage} board raising a feather bed and furniture for each
of my three Daughters, Lucy, Elizabeth & Mary

Lastly I appoint my wife Anna Son Benjamin Executors of this my last
Will and Testament and my friend William Thomas & George Gurley Trustees
see that this my Will and Testament be duly executed In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 26th day of March 1781
