In the name of God amen I Thomas Francis of Southampton county  
being well of good health thank to almighty God do hereby do make &  
appoint this my last will & testament I commend my soul to God that  
gave it in hope of a joyful resurrection of the same & my body to be  
buried at the discretion of my executors hereafter mentioned & as to  
what worldly goods it hath pleased God to bestow on me I dispose of them  
in the manner following

Item

I give to my son John the plantation whereon I now live containing  
one hund<sup>d</sup> acres of land more or less to him & his heirs for ever with paying  
his father Shadrach Francis twenty pounds current money at the term of  
his coming of age

Item

I give to my son Frederick Francis one cow & calf

Item

I give to my son Benjamin Francis one cow & calf

Item

I leave the remainder of my estate after my debts & funeral charges are  
paid to the use of my wife & children that are under age at my wife's  
death or marriage to be equally divided between my children

I do appoint my loving wife Ann of my own Will Francis executor  
of this my last will & testament hereby revoking all other wills by  
me made & do ordain this to be in full force
