I give to my Wife Ann Holliman all my Household Goods & Chattels.

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During her life and after her death my desire is it should be
equally Divided between the said Arthur Prory Nathan
Jesse Holloman my desire is that my Negro Man Peter should
be sold for ready money and out of that money I give to my Brother
James John Holloman's eldest Daughter Lucy Holloman £5.0 Cash

I give to foresaid Brother's Daughter Mary Clayton £5.0 Cash

I give to John Holloman's son Howell Holloman £5.0 Cash

I give the remainder of the effects my Negro Peter to be equally
Divided as the best of my Estate

I give my Plantation and tract of Land after the Death of my Wife
Ann to William Holloman son of my Brother William to him
and his heirs forever

I appoint my Wife Mrs Holloman and Nathan Holloman my
Executors to this my last Will and Testament revoking all other
Wills heretofore made by me as Witness my Hand & Seal
