Th<sup>o</sup> Jewell In the Name of God Amen I Thomas Jewell of the County  
of Southampton do make and ordain this my last will and Testament  
in manner and form following First I Commit my soul into the hands  
of Almighty God my Body to be buried at the Discretions of my Exors  
Hereafter named and my Real & Personal Estate I Give and Dispose  
thereof in manner and Form following Viz  
I give and bequeath unto my Son Th<sup>o</sup> Jewell a small piece of Ground  
Lying below Micajah Edwards mill Path to him and his Heirs forever

Likewise I Give him a Metalle man named W<sup>m</sup> the Performing  
 Father will Concerning him to him and his heirs forever

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my son John Farrell the Plantation whereon  
 W<sup>m</sup> Newton now Lives and all the Land that Lies on the upper side of the  
 Indian Branch that I Bought of the Nottoway Indians. I Also give unto  
 my son John all that Tract of Land I Purchased of Peter Butts Lying on the  
 White oak meadow I also give him my mill on the Angelica Swamp and  
 all the Land thereunto belonging that I Purchased of James Ridley  
 I also Give him Four Negroes Viz: Phillip Ben Lydia and Lucy I give  
 the above three tracts of land & four Negroes to my son John Farrell and to  
 his Heirs forever

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my son Benj<sup>a</sup> Farrell my Plantation where  
 on I now Liveth with all the Land thereunto belonging except a small  
 piece of Wood already Given my son Tho: Farrell as above I also give  
 him a small Survey of Land Lying in the Desert. I Also Give him all my  
 Land that I Bought of the Nottoway Indians Lying below the Indian

Branch I give the above said three tracts or parcels of Land to my son  
Benj. Jarrell and his heirs forever only. Desire my wife shall live on  
the Plantation whereon I now live & during her Natural life.  
Twelfth I Desire that if my son Benj. Jarrell shall die under Twenty  
one years old I give to my son John Jarrell the piece of Land above  
mentioned lying below the Indian branch that I bought of the Nottoway  
Indians to him and his heirs forever. I also give my son Benj. Jarrell  
Five negroes V. James Tom boy Arrey Luke & Sarah the above five  
Negroes I give my son Benj. Jarrell to him and his heirs forever. Also give  
him ten head of the Cattle w<sup>ch</sup> I Desire may be put on that Land give  
him above bought of the Nottoway Indians with the Negroes given him  
him thereon to cultivate the said Land and keep the stock to support  
him in his Senage.

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Ann Richards Four Negroes V.  
Eden Haley Simon & Andrew I give the said four Negroes to Daughter Ann  
Rich to her and to her heirs forever.

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Jarrell four Negroes

W<sup>m</sup> Davy Easter M<sup>rs</sup>g<sup>y</sup> Hester I give the above four Negroes to my Daughter Elizabeth Jarrell to her and to her heirs forever

Item I give and Bequeath unto my Grandson Tho<sup>s</sup> Jarrell two Negroes Viz. Bob & Jone to him and his heirs forever

Item I give and Bequeath the Use of Four Negroes to my Loving Wife Martha Jarrell Viz. Jack Red Doll & Great Jenny during her Natural Life

Item I give and Bequeath unto my Loving wife Martha Jarrell one Negro Woman Cal'd Pess & one fifth part of the Personal Estate to her and to her heirs forever

Item I give and Bequeath unto my four Children Viz. John Jarrell Benj<sup>m</sup> Jarrell Ann Rich<sup>d</sup> & Elizabeth Jarrell all the Remainder part of my Estate with them four Negroes unto my wife both Real & Personal to them and their heirs forever to be equally divided

Lastly I Do constitute and appoint my wife Martha Jarrell and my Son Thomas Jarrell & Rich<sup>d</sup> Rich<sup>d</sup> my Sole & whole Executors of this my last will and Testament Revoking all former Wills and

Testaments by me heretofore made. In Witness whereof I have hereunto
