Charles & Dig to him & his heirs

I give & bequeath unto my son Thomas Moore the land that I have
in Southampton County upon the three creeks also Negroes
Joshua & Jemmy to him and his heirs
I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Moore Negroes
Grace & Lucy to her & her heirs

Item I give Gbequath unto my Daughter Rebecca Moore Negroes Hamilton
of Sudbury to her & her heirs

Item I give Gbequath unto my son John Moore the half of the

and Fanny to him and his heirs
