In the name of God amen I Thomas Cherry of Southampton county
in Virginia being in perfect mind & memory & calling to mind the
uncertainty of this body & that it is appointed for all men to die &
make for an thir my last will & Testament in manner & form
following to wit)

Item I Give devise & bequeath to my son Henry the plantation & lands
whereon he now lives containing one hundred & fifty acres more or less
to him & his heirs for ever

Item I Give devise & bequeath unto my son Nathan one hundred acres of
land lying in the back of the Cyrenus swamp to him & his heirs
for ever

Item I Give devise & bequeath unto my son John the plantation & lands
whereon he now lives containing one hundred acres to him & his heirs
for ever

And Lastly I do appoint my son John Cherry to be my exor of
thir my last will & Testament as witnesses my hand & seal this
17th day of Oct. 1786
