will and Testament that is to say principally and first of all I give
and recommend my soul into the of God that gave it and my
Body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in decent Christian
at the Discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at
The general Resurrection I shall receive the same again by
The mighty power of God as touching such worldly Estate
Where with it hath pleased God to bless me in this life I
give I give and dispose of the same in the following manner
and from I suppose I give and bequeath to him my will
and desire is that all my lands shall be rented to the highest
Bidder every year while my son Thomas Turner is twenty
one years of Age then to be sold to the highest bidder twelve
Months before that time

and from Imprimis I give and bequeath to Him my will
and desire is that all my lands shall be rented to the high
Bidder every year while my son Thomas Turner is twenty
one years of Age then to be sold to the highest Bidder twelve
Months before he is seven years of Age and the price is that
pleas God that three of my Sons shall live before my Son

Thomas Turney is of age 21 that land should not be sold
 But equally divided among the rest of my Sons Item my will
 and desire is that my Negroes Andrew Jim and Jacob
 Hammer Lettes Amay should be hired yearly while my
 Son Thomas Turner is of Age then they and their
 Increase to be sold to the highest bidder twelve months
 credit to be given all the remainder of my Estate consisting
 of my stock of all kind and house hold goods to be sold to the
 Highest bidder

Item My will and desire that after my son Thomas Turner comes
 to the age twenty one that all my Estate is to be Equally
 Divided among my Sons.

Likewise I constitute and appoint Cap^t Nicholas Mag-
 get and William Thorby hole and sole Executors this my
 Last will and Testament.

At a Court held for the county of Southampton the 11 days of April
1771 This will was presented in Court by Nicholas Magel and W^m
Kirby the Executors therein named and proved by the Oath of John Edwards
and Joseph Everil two of the witnesses thereto and Ordered to be recorded
And on the motion of the said Executors who made oath according
to Law a certificate was granted them for obtaining a probat thereof
