Will Phillis of France to him & his heirs lawfully begotten of his body &
in case he should die without issue that then the 2d those negroes Will Phil-
lis & France should return to my son Edmund Trollet of his heirs

I Give of bequeath unto my grandson Robt. Freeman one negro wench named Ben to her
after her

I Give of bequeath unto my grandson Thomas Freeman one negro wench
named Judith to him after her

I Give of bequeath to my grandson Robert Freeman one negro wench named
Patt when he comes to the age of twenty one years he shall have to that
age of days without issue of his body lawfully begotten that then this
negro Patt shall return to my son Edm. Jenkins

I Give of bequeath unto my Daughter Lucy Freeman second son not known
and Christen name one negro fellow named Simon to him after her

I Give of bequeath unto my beloved wife Jean Jenkins the use of my two
negro named Tom & Dee during her life & after her decease to my son
Edm. Jenkins to him after her

It is my will & desire that my son Edm. Jenkins should have the care
of his mother during her life

I Give of bequeath unto my loving son Edmund Jenkins five negroes named
Catherine, Peter, Bristol, Frank & Sarah to him after her

I Give unto my son Edmund Jenkins all the residue of my estate real & personal
& do constitute & appoint my loving son Edmund Jenkins my whole

I have unto my son Edmund Jenkins all the residue of my estate consisting
of the confiture & appoynt my loving son Edmund Jenkins my whole
portion ever of this my last will & Testament of I do hereby revoke & annul
& make void all former wills & Testaments by me herebefore made
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal
the 10 day of August 1764
