being of Perfect sense & Memory do make & Ordain
this my Last Will & Testament in manner & form
following Item I give unto my Son John Cumpler
the Plantation I Live on & the Land belonging to the
said Plantation from the upper end to the Branch below
the Houses to the Bounds running up the said Branch
to an Ash a line Tree Standing in the said Branch
the said Land containing one hundred Acres more
or less to him & his heirs forever & also sixty five Acres
be the same more or less it being part of a Survey
of one hundred & thirty Acres of Land & is Divided by a
line of marked trees between William Cumpler & my
Son John Cumpler I give the said sixty five Acres of
Land to my Son John Cumpler & his heirs forever
Item I give unto my Son William Cumpler the

to an Ash a lone Tree Standing in the said Branch
the said Land Containing one hundred Acres more
or less to him & his heirs forever & also sixty five Acres
be the same more or less it being part of a Survey
of one hundred & thirty Acres of Land & is Divided by a
line of marked trees Between William Cumber & my
Son John Cumber I give the said sixty five Acres of
Land to my Son John Cumber & his heirs forever
Item I give unto my Son William Cumber the
Remaining part of the two tracts of Land & after my
Sons Death I give the Remaining parts of the two
Tracts of Land aforesaid to my Grandson William
Cumber Son of my Son W^m Cumber & to his heirs forever
Item I give unto my Granddaughter Daughter of my
Grandson W^m Cumber by name Sila Cumber one

Feather Bed & furniture belonging to it by two putter Dishes
 and two putter Basons & two plates to her & her heirs
 But if my said Grand Daughter Dies before she
 comes to the age of eighteen the said Legacy to return
 to my Grandson William Crumpler to which I give
 Rest of my Estate goods Chattles to him & his heirs
 forever and I do appoint my Son William Crumpler
 my Executor to this my Last Will & Testament
 Revoking all others Wills hereafter made by me
 Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
 Seal this 29th day of October 1750.
