I give and bequeath unto my Grandson John Hudson Deloach son of my son John Deloach the sum of one hundred & twenty pounds which sum is to be paid by my executors if the said John Hudson Deloach shall arrive to the age of twenty one years and not before.

Also I give devise & bequeath unto my son Benjamin Deloach the plantation whereon I now live dwell with all the lands I am Intitled to adjoining the same to hold to my said son Benjamin Deloach and his heir and assigns forever

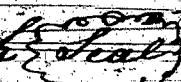
Also I give unto my said son Benjamin Deloach these following Negro Slaves (to wit) Dick Jack Moses Arthur Beck with her Children Roger Tillar Flora Tamps. Tem Isaham & tom together with the future Increase of the said Slaves to hold to my said son Benjamin Deloach & to his heirs assigns forever

Also all the rest residue & remainders of my estate of what nature or kind soever I give and devise & bequeath unto my afore said son Benjamin Deloach & to his heirs forever It is my intention that the Legacy of my said son one hundred & twenty pounds herein before given to my Grandson remain in my estate to my son Benjamin Deloach provided my said Grandson shall not arrive

to the age of twenty one as aforesaid & that no interest is hereby intended to best in him until he arrives to the aforesaid age and do hereby appoint my said son Benjamin Delouch executor of this my will In Witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand and affixed my Seal this Eleventh day of April 1772
